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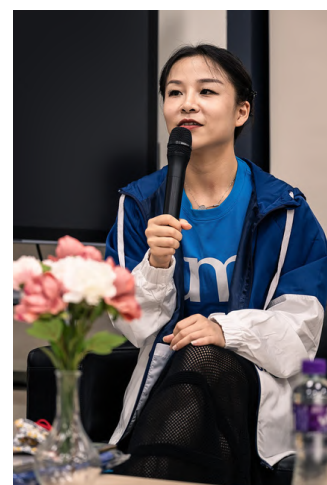
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World Champion shares her successful story at Lui Che Woo College



On 15th November 2022, the former badminton world champion MA Jin was invited to Lui Che Woo College as a guest for the activity “5th LCWC Forum – Talk with World Champion”.

The event started with the presentation of souvenirs and a certificate of appreciation to Ma Jin by College Master Prof. Desmond LAM Chee Shiong. The event was then presided over by Associate Master Prof. CHAO Kuok Fai. Through a simple question and answer format, MA Jin interacted with more than 40 LCWC students and discussed meaningful issues with them such as “what was it like to be a student at the University of Macau” and “how to deal with adversity”. She shared her own experiences, and mentioned “You do not realize that the opportunity is coming when it comes” and “It will be too late to prepare when you realize that the opportunity has come” in order to encourage students to be better prepared for their future and equip themselves with relevant skills.

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Academic Section

In order to create a conducive academic atmosphere at LCWC, we have established an Academic Section. LCWC Academic Section is mainly responsible for the organization and promotion of academic activities at LCWC. Moreover, Academic Section provides personal academic development to, and suggestions for, our college students.

Global Management Competition

This is an international competition held annually, where competing teams simulate the running of a company. Each competing team comprises three to five people. The decision-making involves the company's development strategy, production, R&D, marketing, human resources, investment and finance, etc., while interspersed with finance, trade, accounting, futures, investment, and information technology and other disciplines, to maximize the simulation of the company's real operating conditions under market economic conditions.

In this year, LCWC sent two teams of students under the advisory of College Master Prof. Desmond LAM. One of our teams successfully entered into the second round. Team members expressed that such competition is a great chance for them to apply different business theories and integrate their knowledge with practice.



STR Market Analytic Competition

A team of six students from different majors took part in the STR Student Market Study Competition 2022. They were led by College Master and Associate Master. Participants of the competition came from universities around the world. Each team selected a market to research and present their findings to a panel of senior-level industry judges.

This year, our team selected Shenzhen as their target market. After three months of hard work on data analysis and thorough investigation, LCWC team came in the 6th place. We believe such activities can enhance the academic environment/culture for resident students, and encourage students from diverse background to work together for a common goal. The competition cultivated students' teamwork and leadership abilities. We look forward to seeing more students participate in such meaningful international competitions in the near future.



English Training Session

English is the medium of instructions at the University of Macau. The ability to read, write and speak in good English strengthens the global competitiveness of our students and put them in a better position to successfully apply for further studies overseas. Thus, LCWC held regular English language training throughout each academic year. This year, our student leaders organized an IELTS oral practice session. 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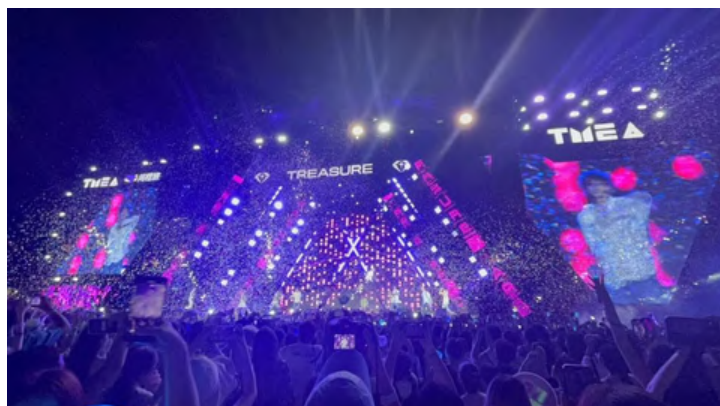
World Table Tennis Tournament

Lanzhou University :Psychology Research Camp



Students and staff of Lui Che Woo College (LCWC) visited Lanzhou in late May to participate in the "Chinese Excellent Traditional Cultural Psychology Research Camp", which was organized by the School of Basic Medical Science of Lanzhou University. This research camp provided a great platform where academic staff and students from both universities interact closely with each other. Most importantly, the visit enabled LCWC students and staff to gain a deeper understanding of traditional Chinese culture through the learning of expressive artistic techniques of applied psychology such as Baduanjin, mural psychotherapy and aromatherapy. Such profound experiences of Chinese heritage inspired LCWC students' imagination and strengthened their social responsibility. Students also made use of this opportunity to learn more about how to prepare activities relating to mental health and social services.



The research camp lasted for nine days. During this period, students and staff of LCWC visited Dunhuang Grottoes, Mingsha Mountain and Crescent Lake, Jiayuguan, Danxia landform and Ganga Secret Realm, and also studied as well as carried out the desertification control project for Mingsha Mountain. Through these activities, LCWC students could more intuitively understand the long history of the western part of the motherland, the rich reserves of the Silk Road and the great wonders of traditional Chinese culture. Overall, this research camp was an excellent occasion to enhance students' competencies and deepen scientific research collaboration between the University of Macau and Lanzhou University.

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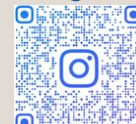
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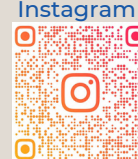
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
