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
### Grand Prix Macau

The mid-autumn festival party jointly organized by LCWC and CKPC was successfully held with a strong, lively festive atmosphere.




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## Service Learning Program




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### SINGAPORE

To enhance students' global perspective and knowledge, LCWC organized a study tour to Singapore for its students and staff. The study tour provided them with the opportunity to engage in cultural and knowledge exploration and experiential learning, broadening their knowledge in areas such as engineering, business, and social sciences.

Our group of 22 students and staff resided at the College of Alice and Peter Tan (CAPT) in the National University of Singapore (NUS). They visited the Engineering Design and Innovation Centre and discussed with their professor topical issues related to the integration of academic knowledge with industrial practices in the real world. The group also visited the Institute for the Public Understanding of Risk and explored a range of academic topics including growth mindset and healthy ageing. During their visit to the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, LCWC members met with vice deans of the faculty and learned about the various academic programmes offered by the faculty as well as career opportunities in Singapore. Moreover, while in Singapore, our group was given a guided tour of the Nanyang Technological University by their professors. Beyond academics, this study trip included learning tours of Singapore's international resorts - the Resorts World Sentosa and Marina Bay Sands.

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
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### Tokyo, JAPAN

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### Wuhan, CHINA

This year, China University of Geosciences "Wuhan" invited the Lui Che Woo College of the University of Macau to participate in a 10-day "Beautiful Yangtze River" geological and geomorphological field investigation and Jingchu cultural exchange activities.

Thirteen students and staff visited the China University of Geosciences (Wuhan). The LCWC group had in-depth and personal learning experiences of the culture of Wuhan and the surrounding Jingchu region. They had science lectures about Yangtze River geoscience, conducted geological field investigations at the production-study-research base in Zigui, and visited the Three Gorges Dam. These diverse research and learning activities provided meaningful information about the current state of development of Mainland China, allowing our students to better grasp the overall trend of the country's development, while providing students from both universities a platform to interact and exchanges ideas.



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### Chinese University of Hong Kong (Shenzhen)

On 19th November 2023, LCWC delegation visited The Chinese University of Hong Kong (Shenzhen) and its Minerva College. The visit focused on cultural heritage, while fostering cross-cultural exchange and exploring collaboration opportunities. The delegation also had the chance to appreciate the campus facilities and celebrate Thanksgiving together. The visit strengthened ties between the two residential colleges and set the stage for future collaborations.



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### Pearl River Delta, CHINA

LCWC organized a historical trip to the Pearl River Delta region in Guangdong Province, China.
